# PD 1586 : Philippine EIS System


- No person, partnership or corporation shall undertake or operate any such declared Environmentally Critical Projects or project within an Environmentally Critical Area without first securing an ***Environmental Compliance Certificate (ECC)***.

ECC is a document issued by the DENR/EMB after a positive review of an ECC application, certifying that the proponent has complied with all the requirements of the EIS System and has committed to implement its approved Environmental Management Plan

**EIA** is a planning and management tool that will help government, the proponent, the affected communities and other decision makers assess whether the benefits of the project will outweigh the negative consequences or risks on the environment



# Categorization of Projects

Coal mining	≥ 70,000 MT	> 20,000 MT but < 70,000 MT	≤ 20,000 MT
Extraction of metallic ores (on shore)	≥ 100,000 MT OR ≥ 25 hectares	>20,000 MT but < 100,000 MT and Area < 25 ha	≤ 20,000 MT and Area < 25 hectares
Extraction of Non-metallic minerals	≥ 75,000 MT OR ≥ 20 hectares	> 20,000 MT but < 75,000 MT and Area is < 20 hectare	≤ 20,000 MT and Area < 20 hectares
Metallic Mineral ore processing	≥ 70,000 MT	≥ 10,000 MT but < 70,000 MT	> 200 MT but < 10,000 MT
Non-metallic mineral processing plants	≥ 50,000 MT	≥ 10,000 MT but > 50,000 MT	> 200 MT but < 10,000 MT
