

DOST Timeline




Mandate




Food Innovation Centers


What the project is all about








Calawa came up to meet us looking like any other highland farmer -from the bonnet on his head to the thick jacket shielding him from the cold weather to those well-loved jeans, and down to the worn-out slippers on his feet. But let not his looks deceive you. He is in fact a farmer-millionaire.

Jonie owns the Green Salad Farm, established in 1988 to produce high value commercial crops such as romaine lettuce. The three-hectare farm was initially established by his father and, from the start, was aimed to become the lead producer of highland fresh vegetables through the use of greenhouse technologies and good agricultural practices.
