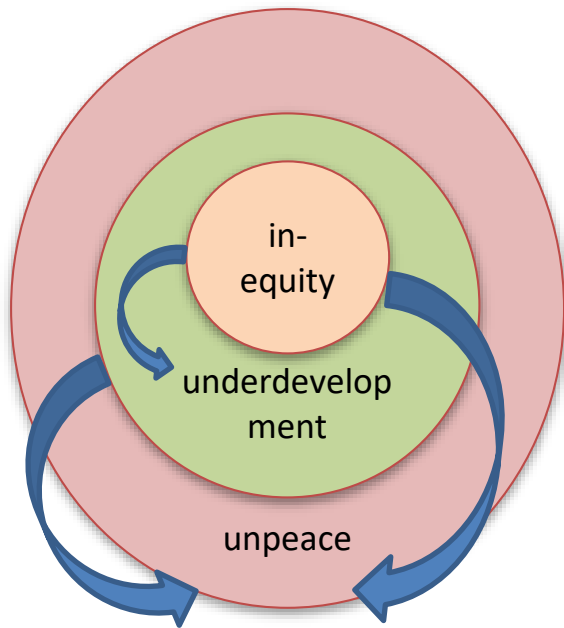

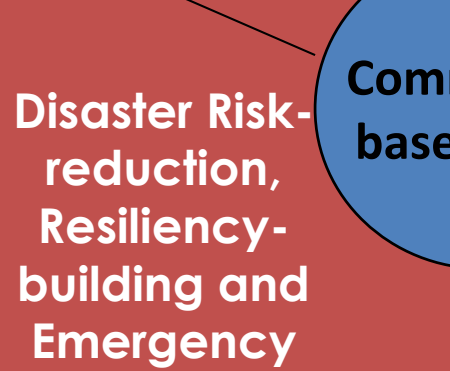

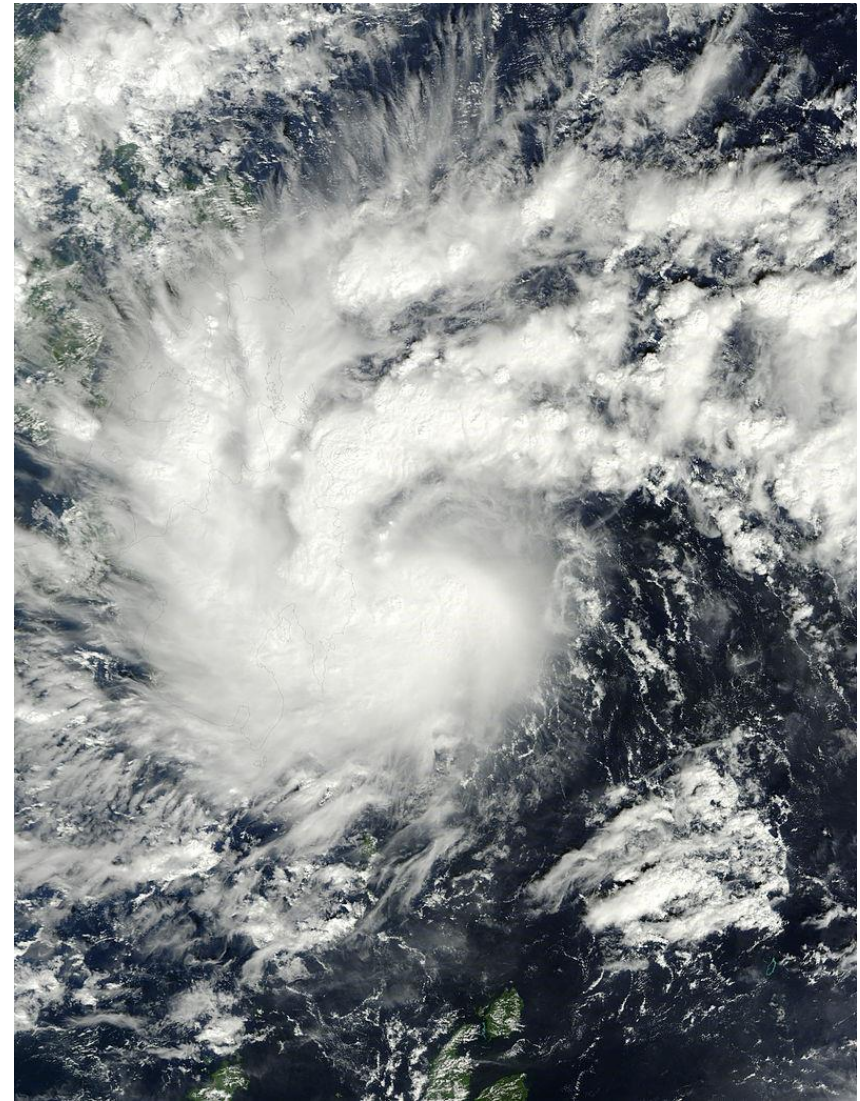

Our DREAM...

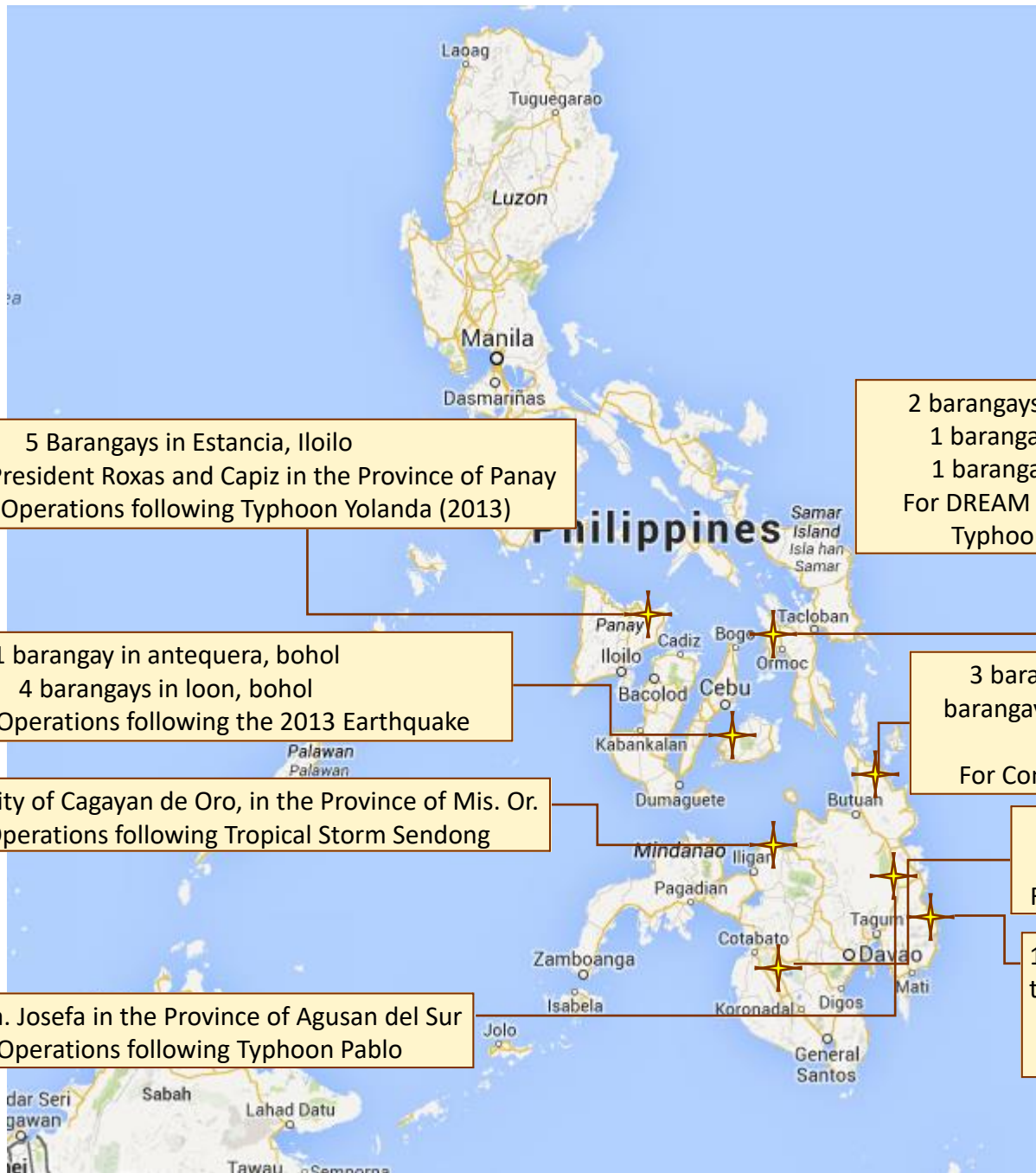
.....is to help empower communities to become sustainable and resilient to disasters (human-made or natural) that may strike in the future.

- Strengthened DRRMCs (barangay to municipal) – more prepared response during typhoons
- More active women leadership and participation



More prepared LGUs and residents in responding to incidents (skills, knowledge and equipment)

55 units donated thru DAI

- 29 units installed into water filtration systems
- 3 units mobile/prepositioned in evacuation centers
- 13 units for installation (all handed over to identified barangays)
- 7 units for hand-over
- 3 units currently used for Marawi Crisis
