THE REPORT ON THE PERFORMANCE OF THE PHILIPPINE AGRICULTURE

- ❑ accomplishments of agriculture during a particular reference period.
- ❑ measured in terms of the gross output produced by the sector.

Gross output is the aggregate value of production from all subsectors (crops, livestock, poultry and fisheries) of agriculture

- ❑ inputs in the estimation of Gross Value Added (GVA) in agriculture

Performance of Agriculture

- focuses on the measurement of the whole sector (agriculture) and its sub-sectors (crops, livestock, poultry and fisheries) and commodities.

Coverage: all agricultural commodities but highlighting 37

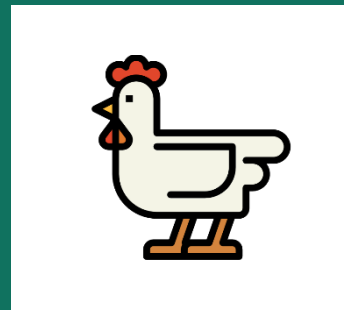

Estimation Procedure

- Valuation is done quarterly and cumulative basis
- Valuation is done in two ways:
 - a) At Constant 2000 Prices
 - b) At Current Prices

Estimation Procedure

At Constant 2000 Prices

- *price valuation measures the aggregate growth of each subsector as well as the whole sector.*

$$VPo = Qt * FGPO$$

where:

VPo = Value of production at constant 2000 prices;

Qt = Volume of production for the current period;

FGPO = Farmgate price at constant 2000 prices

Estimation Procedure

At Current Prices

- *depicts the interplay of prices and volume of commodities produced.*

$$VP_t = Q_t * FG_{Pt}$$

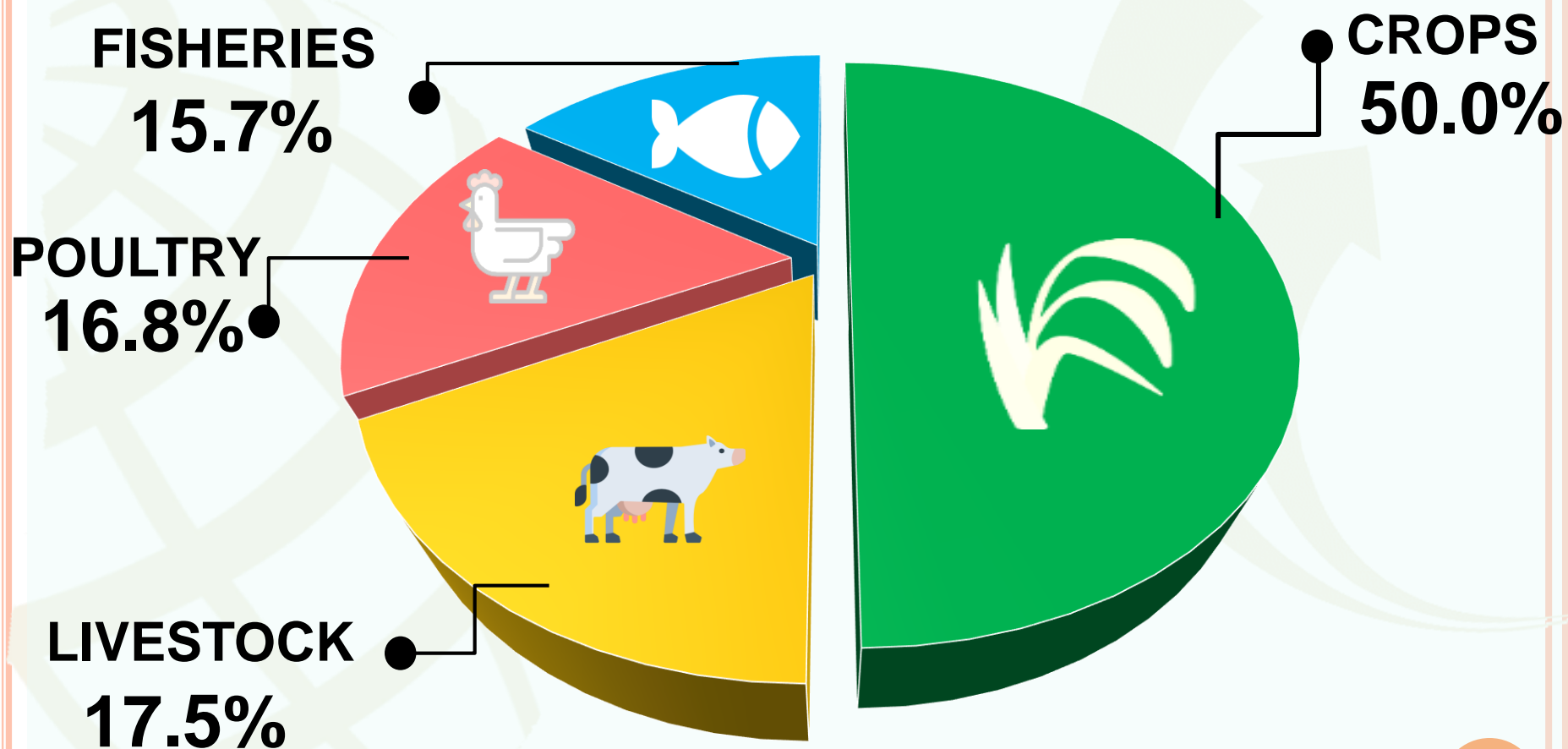
where:

VP_t = Value of production at current prices;

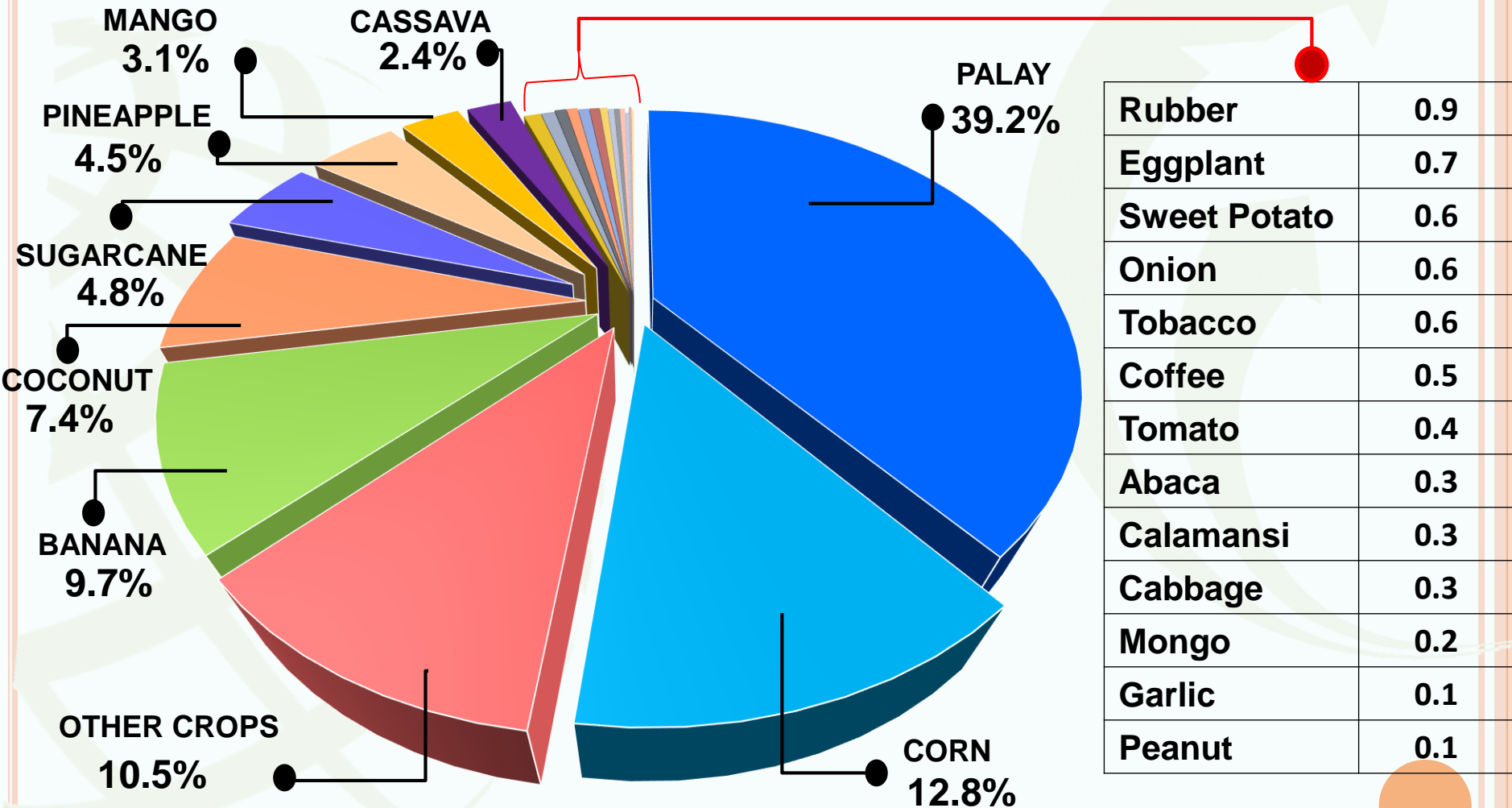
Q_t = Volume of production for the current period;

Percentage Share to Total Agriculture at Constant 2000 Prices, Philippines, 2018

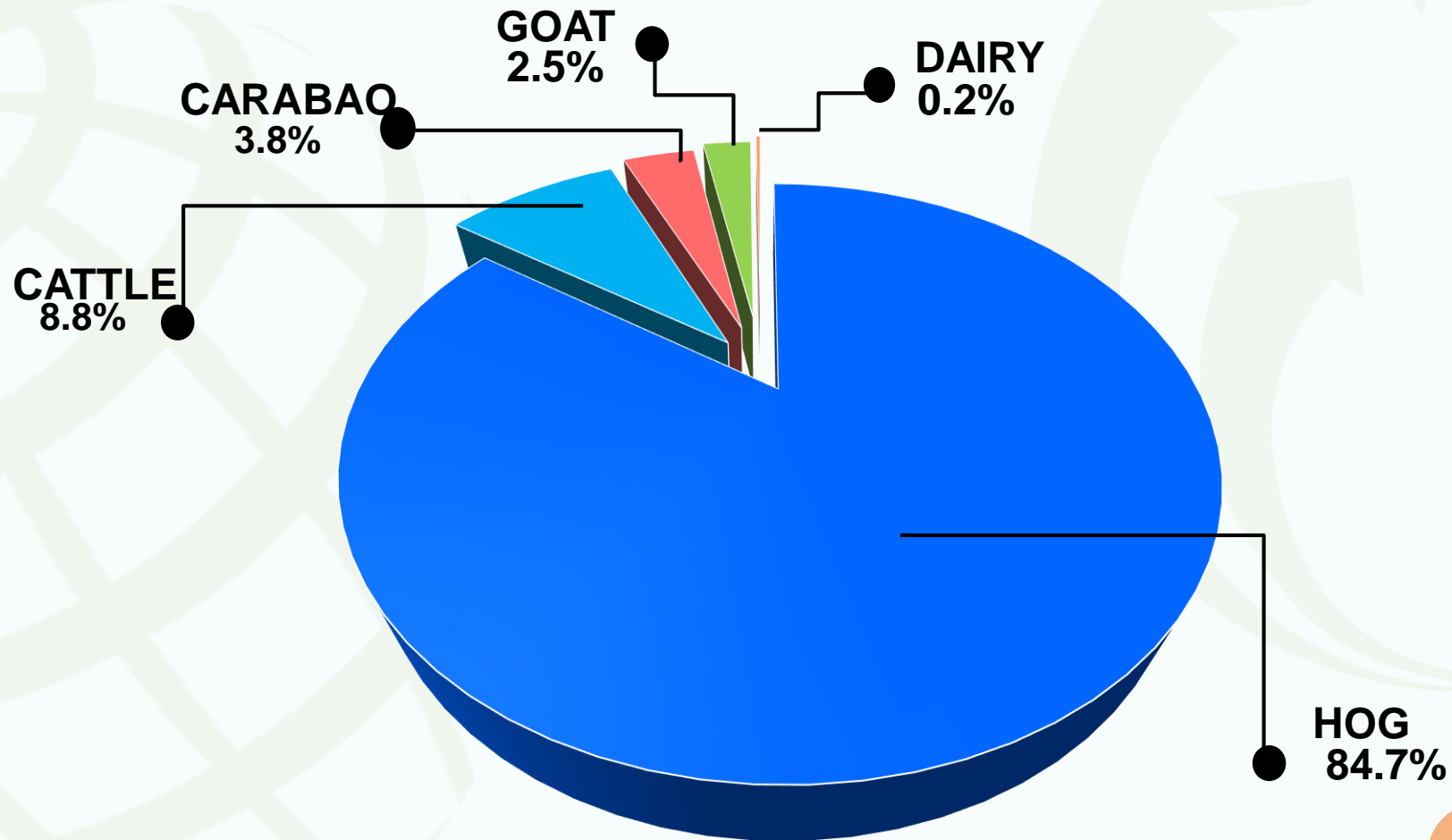


Percentage Share of Highlighted Crops to total Crops at Constant 2000 Prices, Philippines, 2018

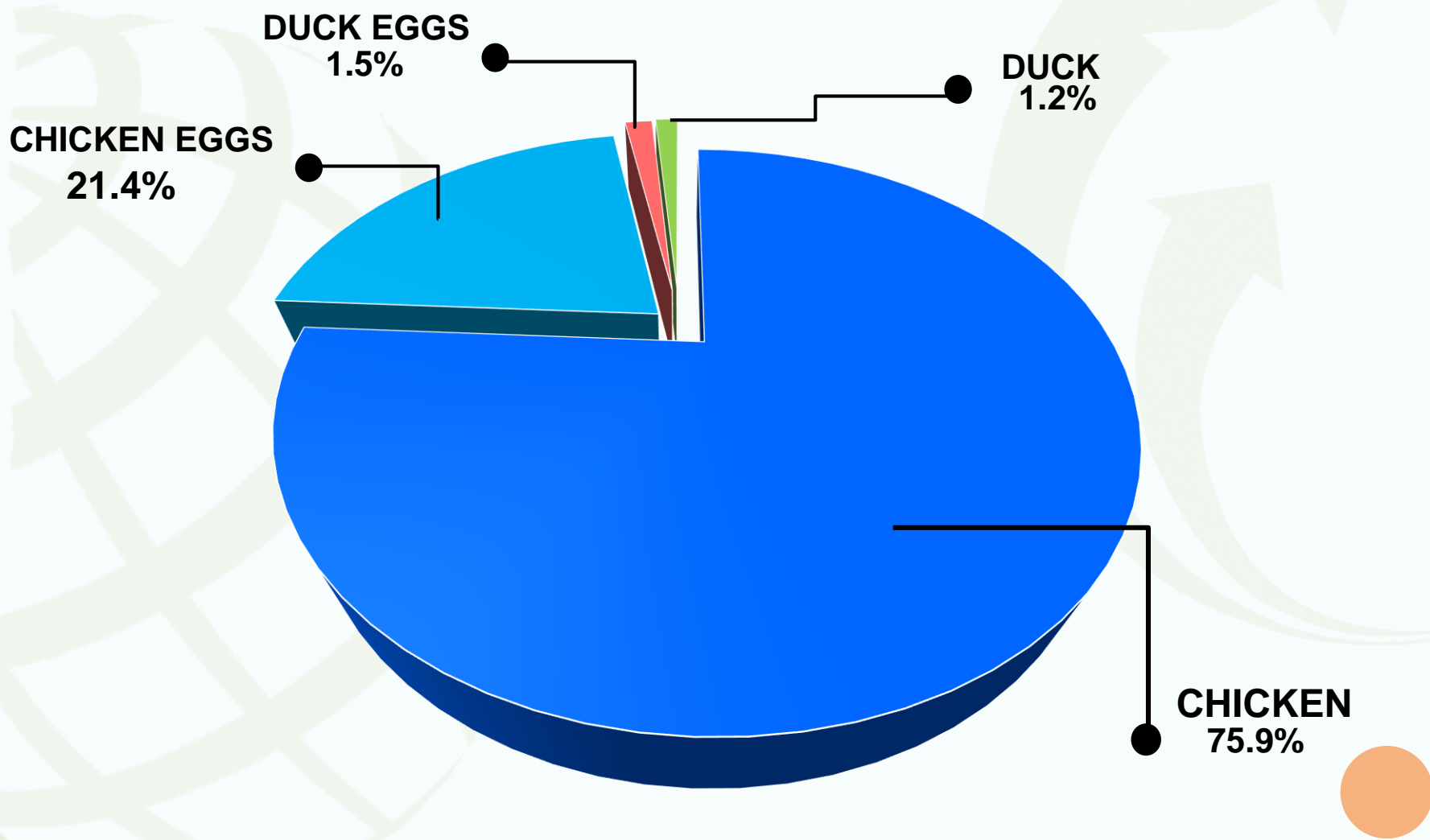

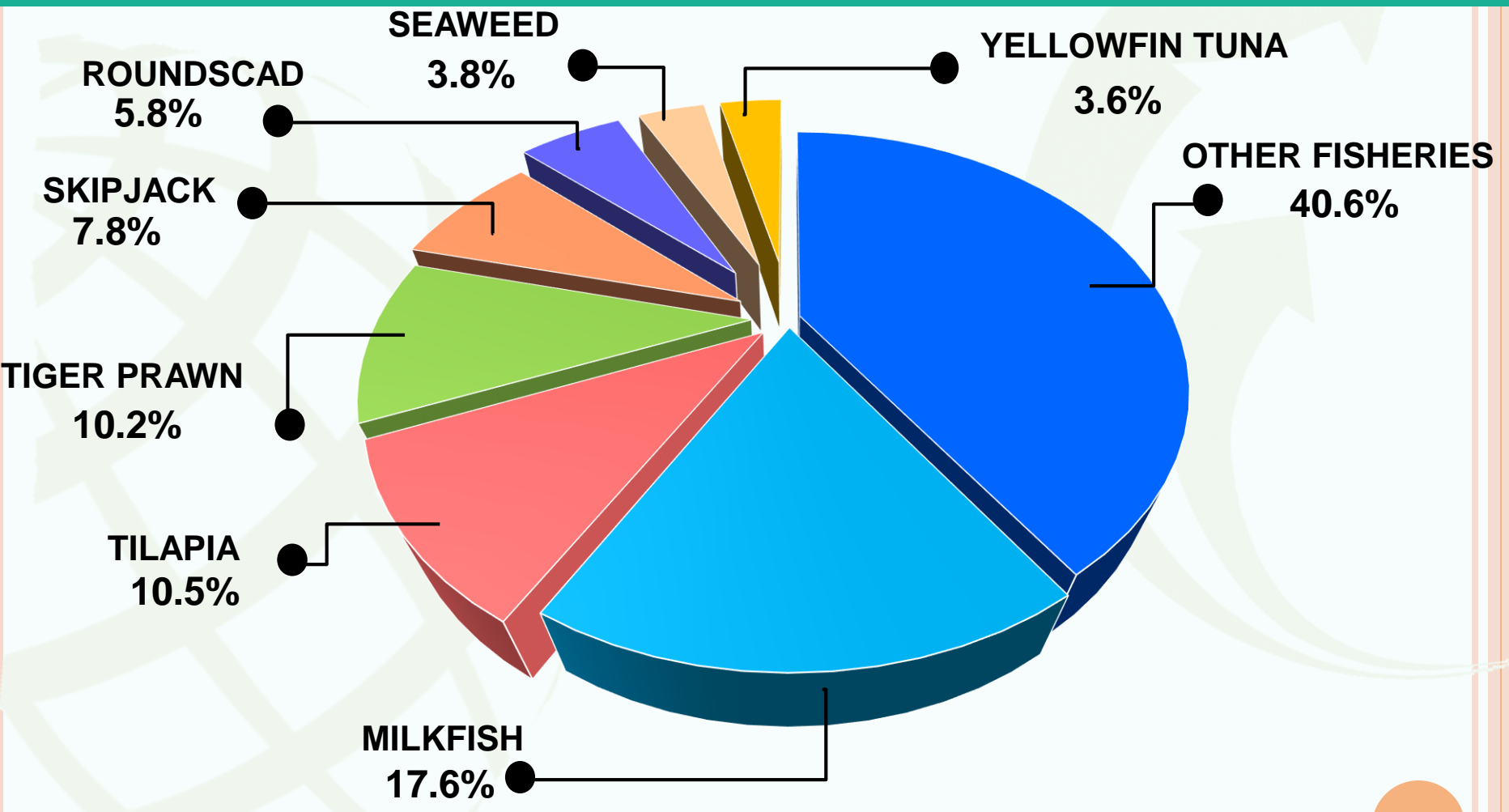
Percentage Share of Commodities to Livestock at Constant 2000 Prices, Philippines, 2018



Percentage Share of Commodities to Poultry at Constant 2000 Prices, Philippines, 2018




Percentage Share of Major Species to Total Fisheries at Constant 2000 Prices, Philippines, 2018



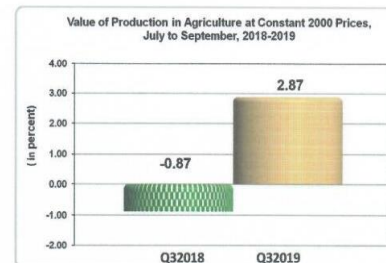

Agriculture Posts 2.87 Percent Growth in Q3 2019

Agricultural production grew by 2.87 percent in the third quarter of 2019. Increases were recorded for crops, livestock, poultry and fisheries.

Crop production which accounted for 45.19 percent of the total agricultural output went up by 2.01 percent during the quarter. Among the major crops, production of corn was up by 23.47 percent while palay production decreased by 4.53 percent.

Livestock production was 1.63 percent higher this quarter. It contributed 18.67 percent to the total agricultural output. Uptrends in production were exhibited by hog at 1.96 percent and dairy at 6.48 percent.

Poultry production registered an 8.41 percent increment this quarter. It shared 19.44 percent in the total agricultural output. All poultry commodities recorded production increases.

Fisheries production which shared 16.70 percent in the total agricultural output grew by 0.56 percent in the third quarter of 2019. Milkfish, skipjack and seaweed registered increases in production.

At current prices, the total value of agricultural production amounted to PHP 395.3 billion, 3.64 percent lower than the previous year's record.

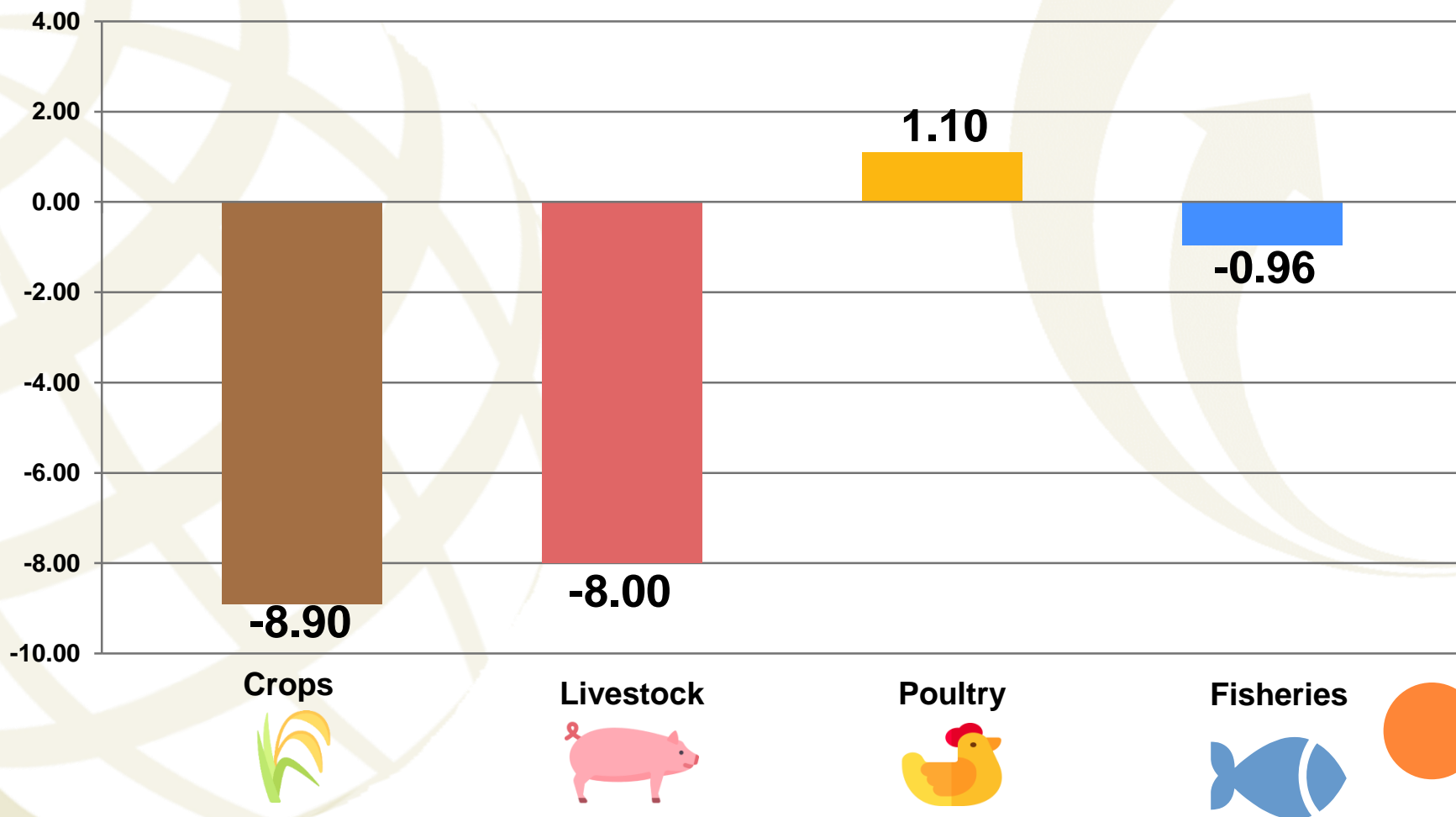

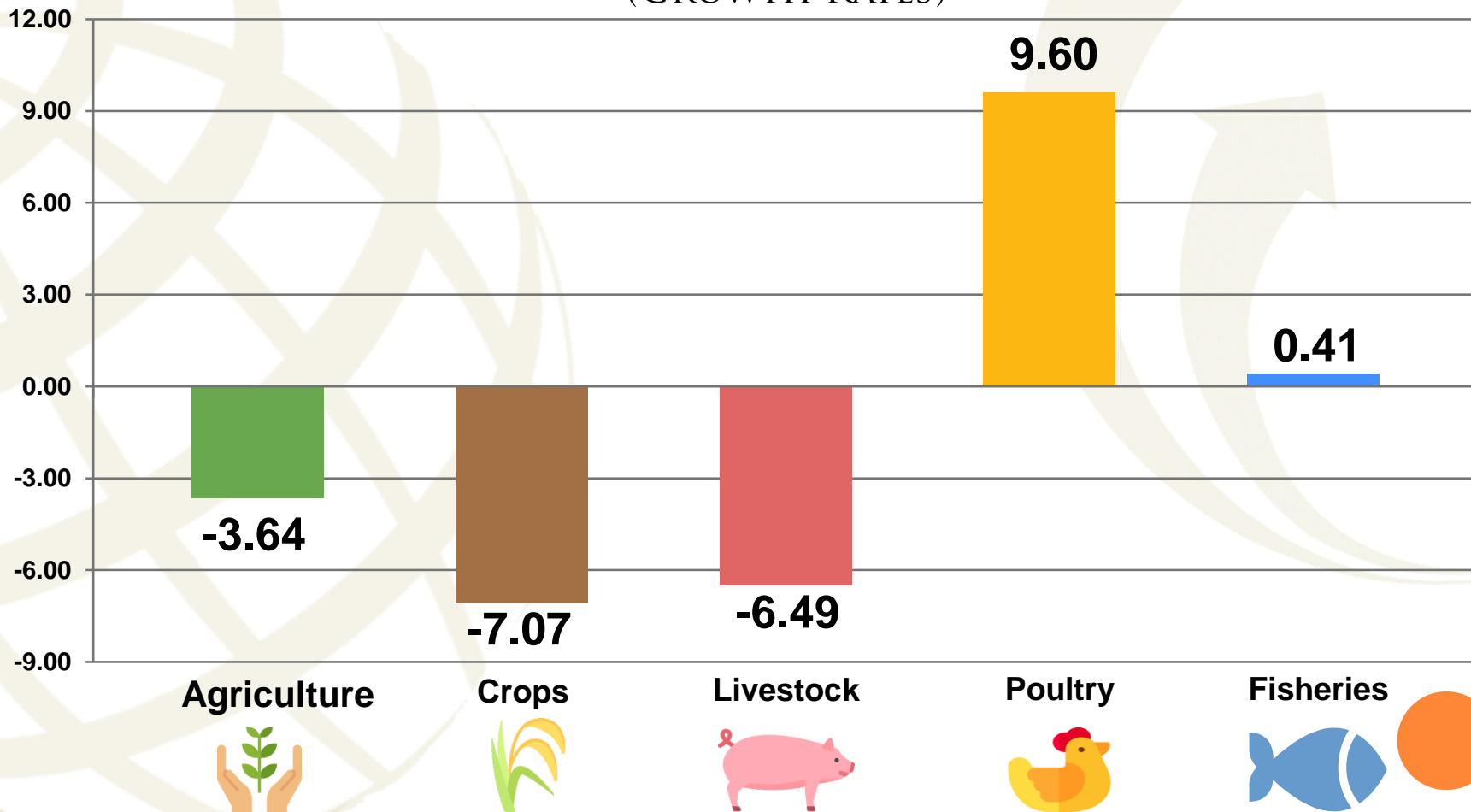
