Actionable Points for the Government

SUPPORT

- Support and monitor existing CBDRPs
- Proper management and treatment of TB among the PWUD population in Drug Abuse Treatment and Rehabilitation Centers (DATRC)

STRENGTHEN

- Conduct Health Needs Assessment (HNA) for better CBDRP implementation
- Strengthen, evaluate, and identify the best practices of CBDRPs to promote and ensure effective implementation
- Strengthen coordination between DATRCs and TB DOTS facilities to ensure treatment compliance without compromising any DATRC protocols

Actionable Points for the Government

ALLOCATE RESOURCES

- Capacity building activities for CBDRP implementers
- Provide training to DATRC staff in managing TB cases
- Include PWUDs as beneficiaries of free treatment from TB DOTS
- Increase campaign in raising awareness on drug use and dependence among health and service providers (HSPs) to promote positive and accepting attitudes towards PWUDs
- Provide training to HSPs to enhance their knowledge and comfort in caring for PWUDs

Actionable Points for the Government

RECOMMENDATIONS

- Develop comprehensive guidelines for CBDRPs
- Integration of public health perspectives including mental health in drug abuse interventions of nonhealth sectors
- Health financing and social health insurance coverage for CBDRP
- Create guidelines in the management of TB among PWUDs in different treatment settings
- Integration of DATRCs in the TB DOTS network either as providing or referring facility

Policy Research Gaps

- Examine the multi-level consequences of substance use
- Develop tools to measure substance use prevalence and patterns
- Develop methodology and tools to evaluate the effectiveness of substance use prevention approaches and interventions
- Examine the various factors in the successful implementation of preventive and rehabilitative strategies

Policy Research Gaps

- Investigate the prevalence of TB among PWUDs in different treatment settings
- Determine best practices on the case handling and management of TB among PWUDs
- Expand the analysis of drug supply and supply reduction strategies
- Evaluate the different drug demand and supply reduction policies
