Situationer

There is an estimated **1.67 Million** persons who are currently using drugs in the country (DDB, 2019)

273, 014 were arrested for involvement with illegal drugs

485, 295 persons who use drugs had completed a recovery program

National Burden of Disease (2019)



Mild Substance Use Disorder

90 - 95% ~1.59 M cases (est.) Moderate Substance
Use Disorder

4 - 5% ~67,000 cases (est.) Severe Substance Use Disorder

> 1-2% ~16,700 cases (est.)






Client Flow for Wellness and Recovery from Substance Related Issues


