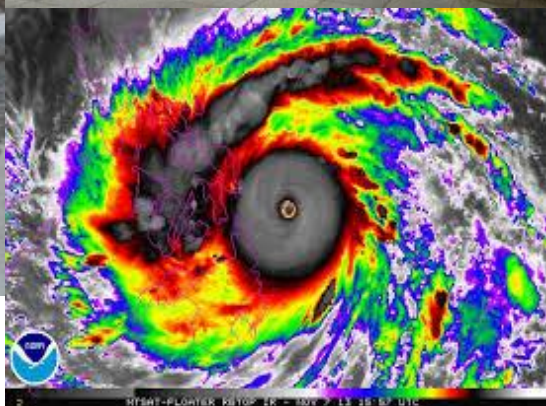

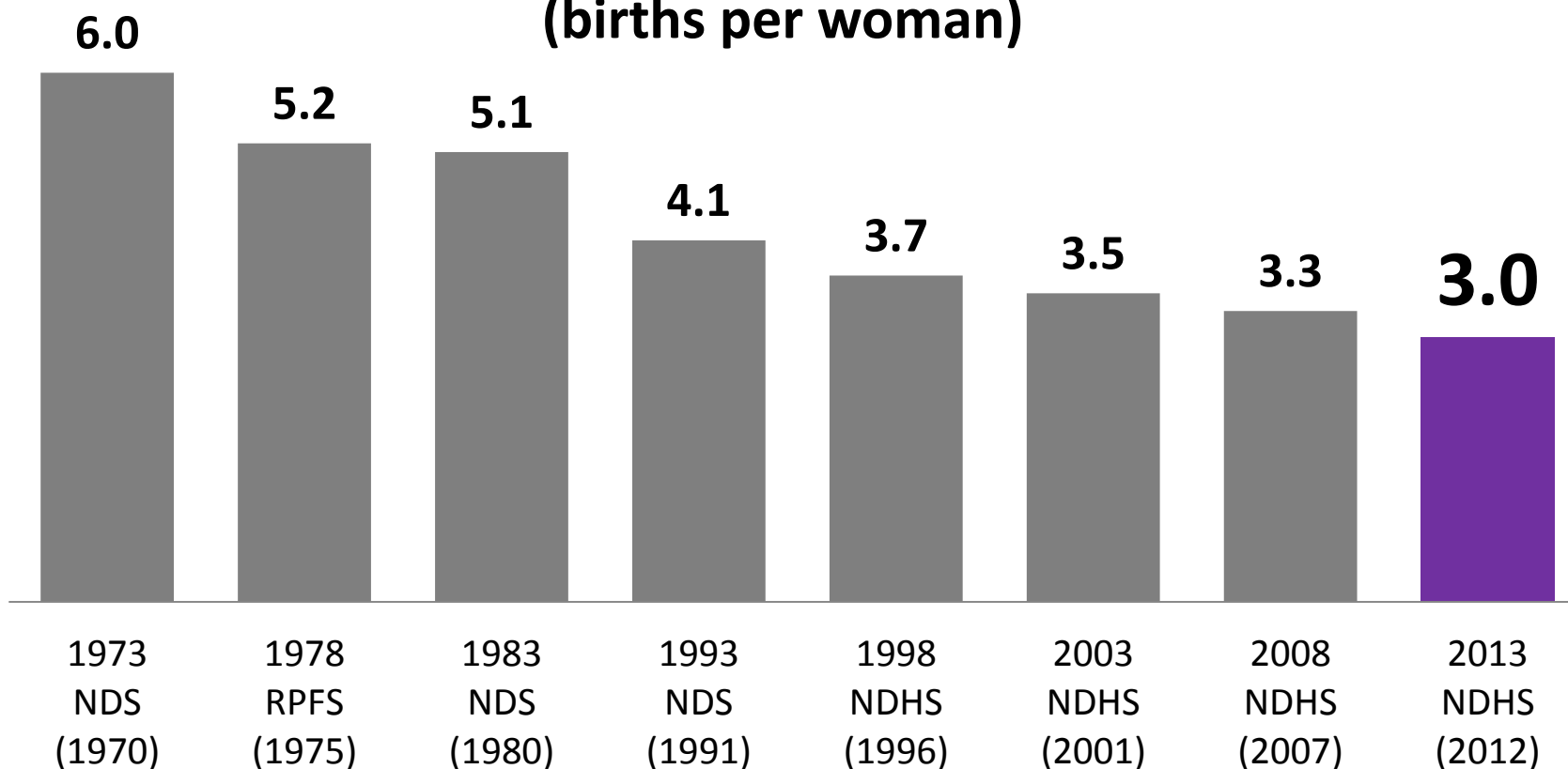

(births per woman)

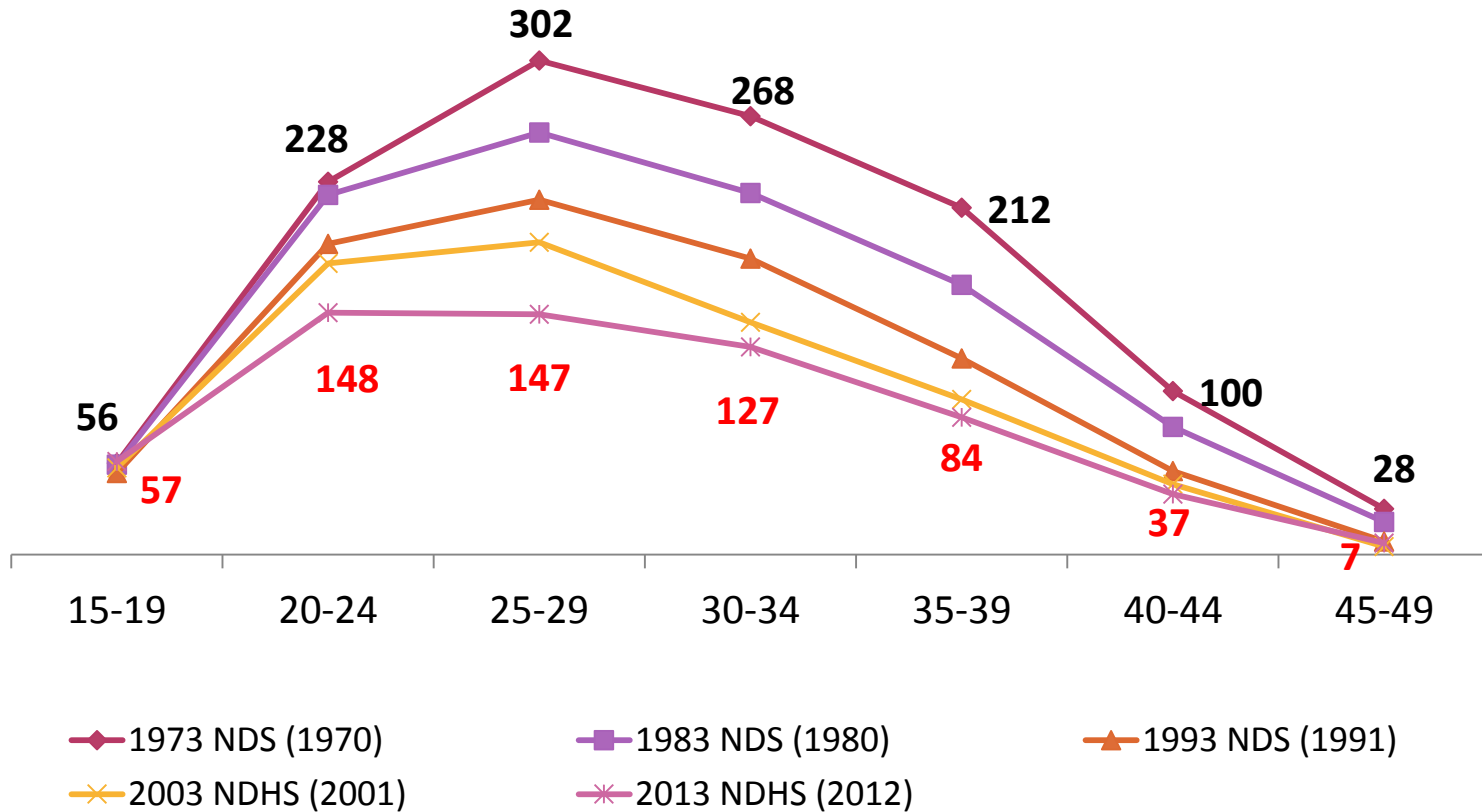




**TFR = 3.0** births per woman

### Age-specific fertility rates, 1973-2013





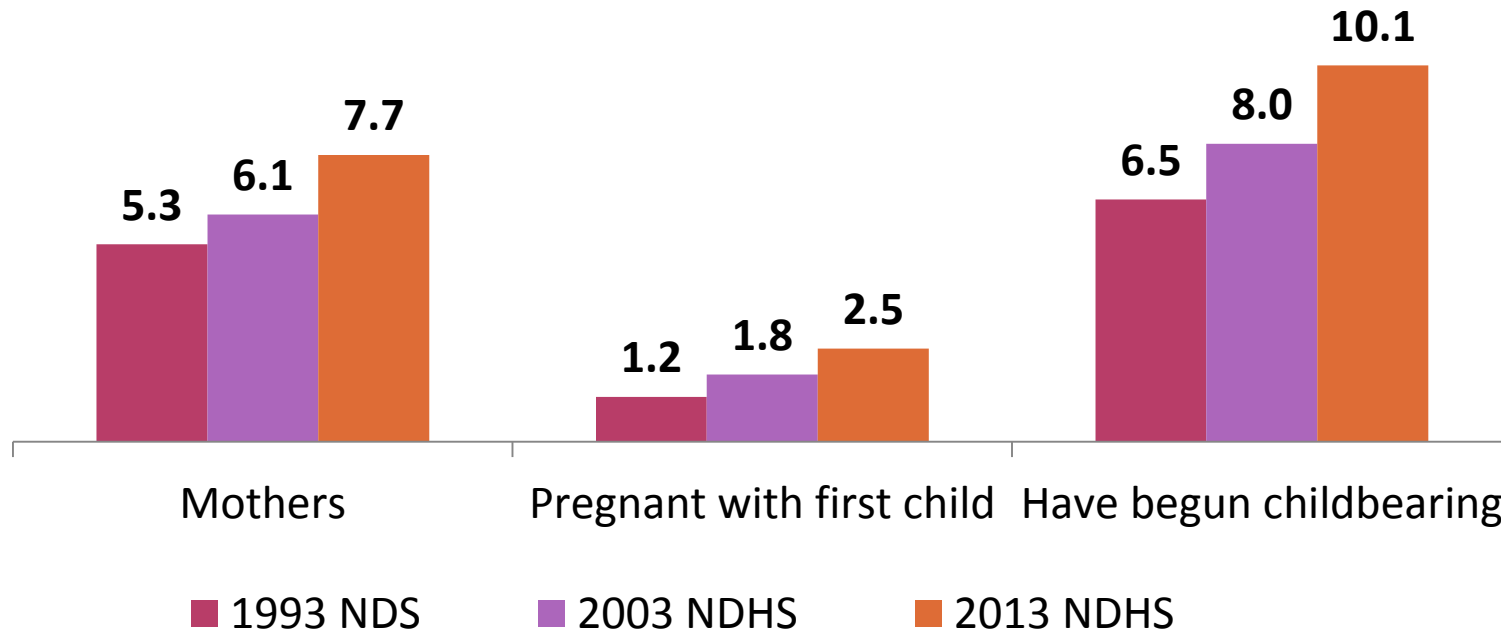

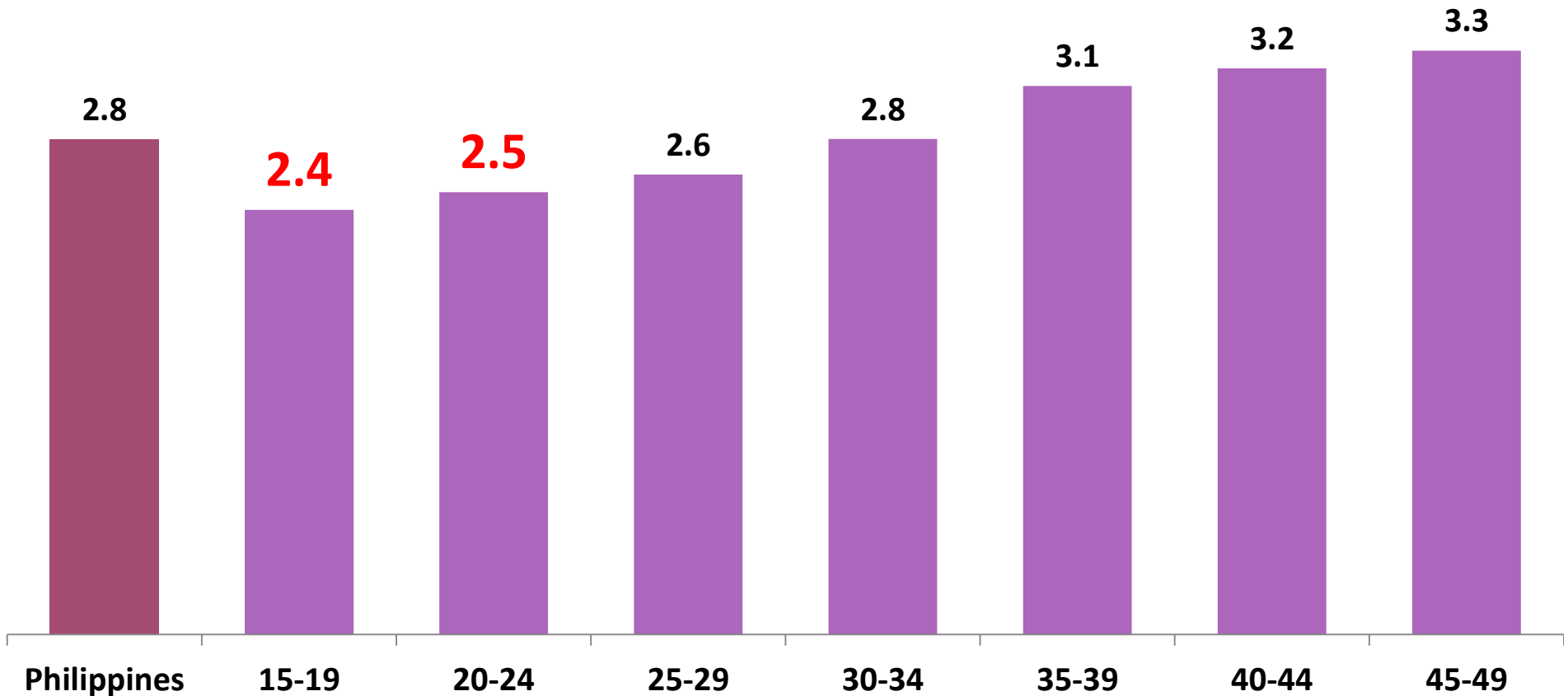

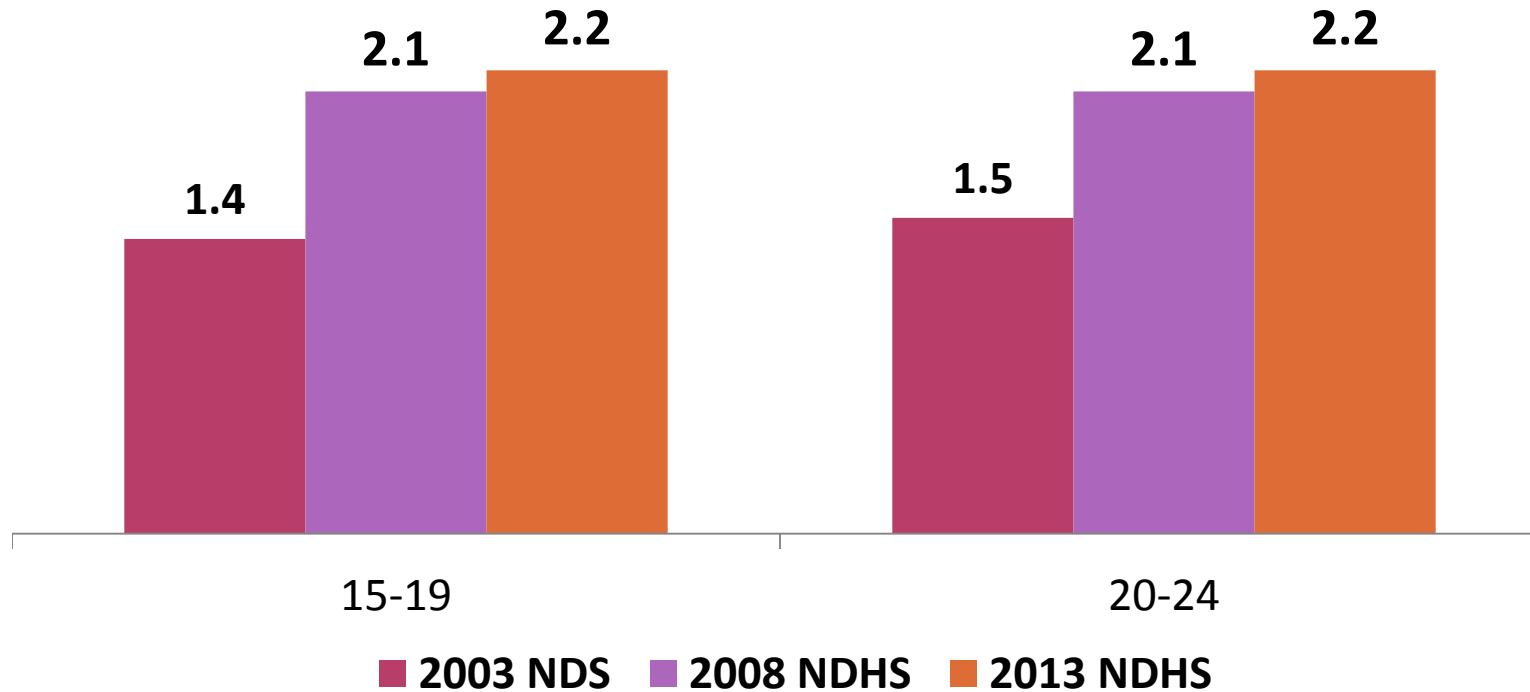


## Mean Ideal Number of Children by Age Group



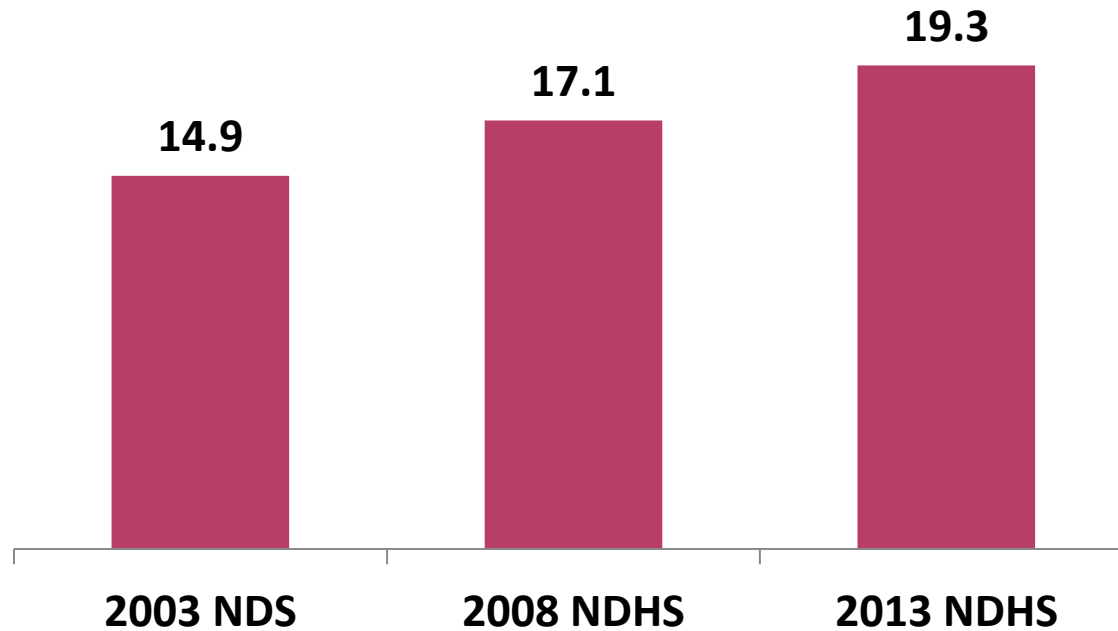


**Percentage of women age 15-24 who had sexual intercourse before age 15**

who had sexual intercourse before age 18**

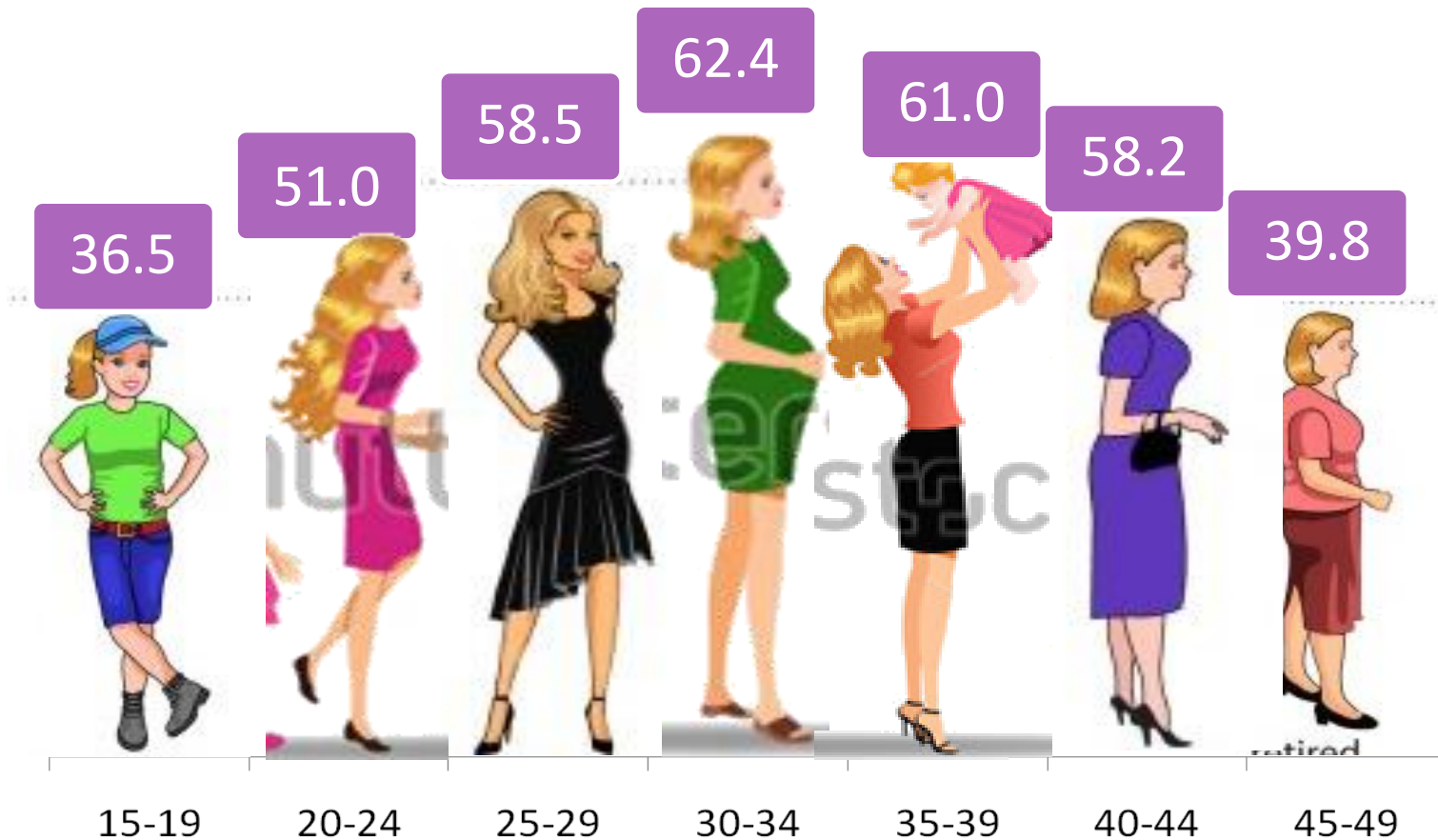

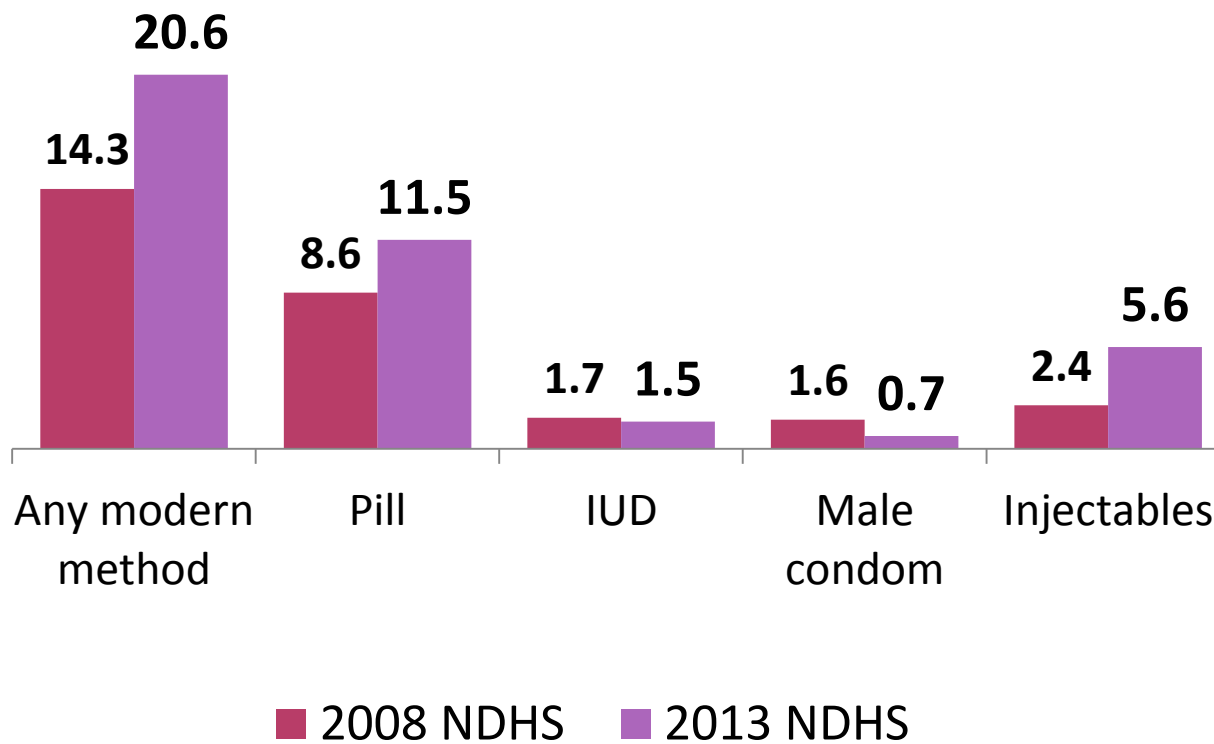
## Percent of Currently Married Women Using Any Contraceptive Method





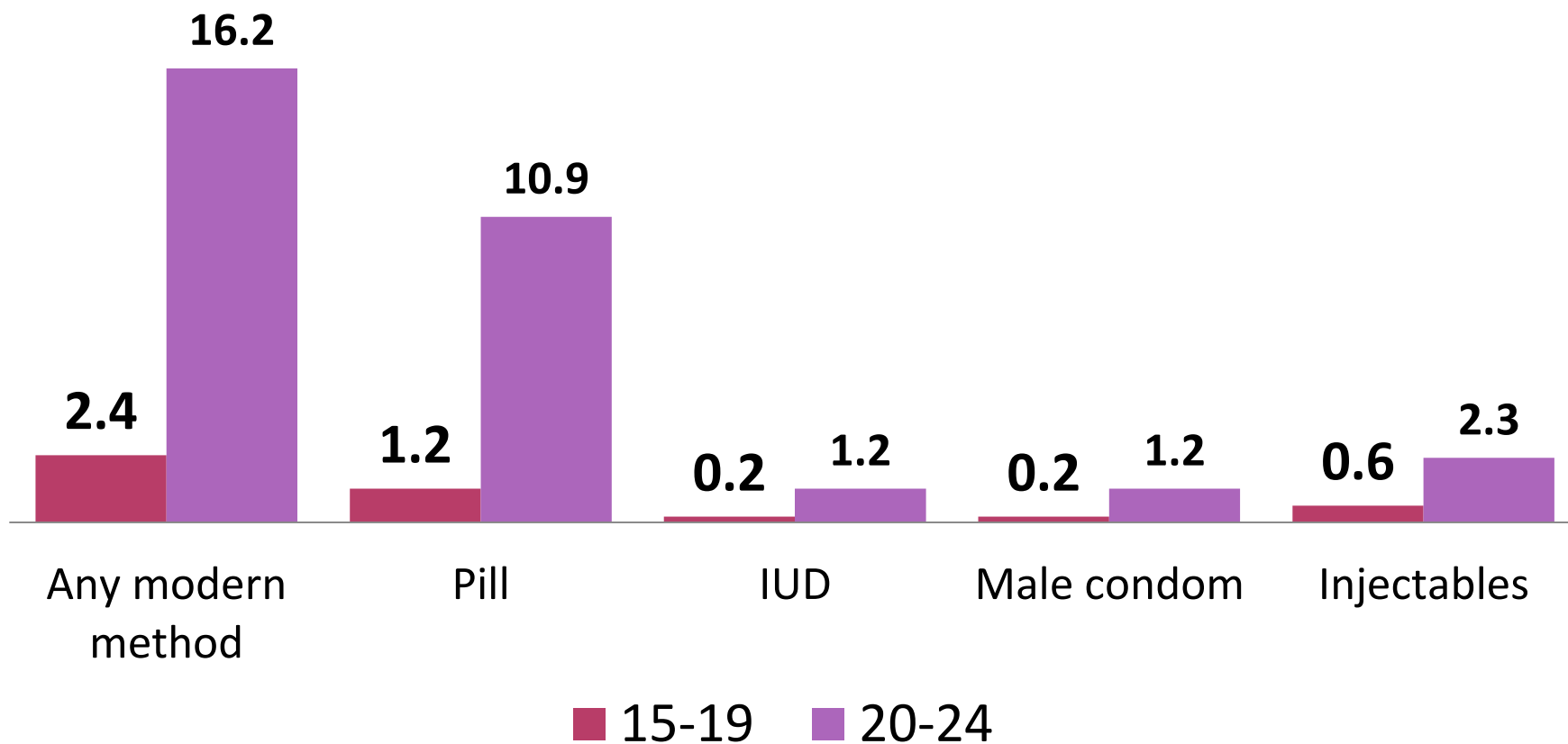


Percent of Currently Married Young Women by

NDHS and 2013 NDHS



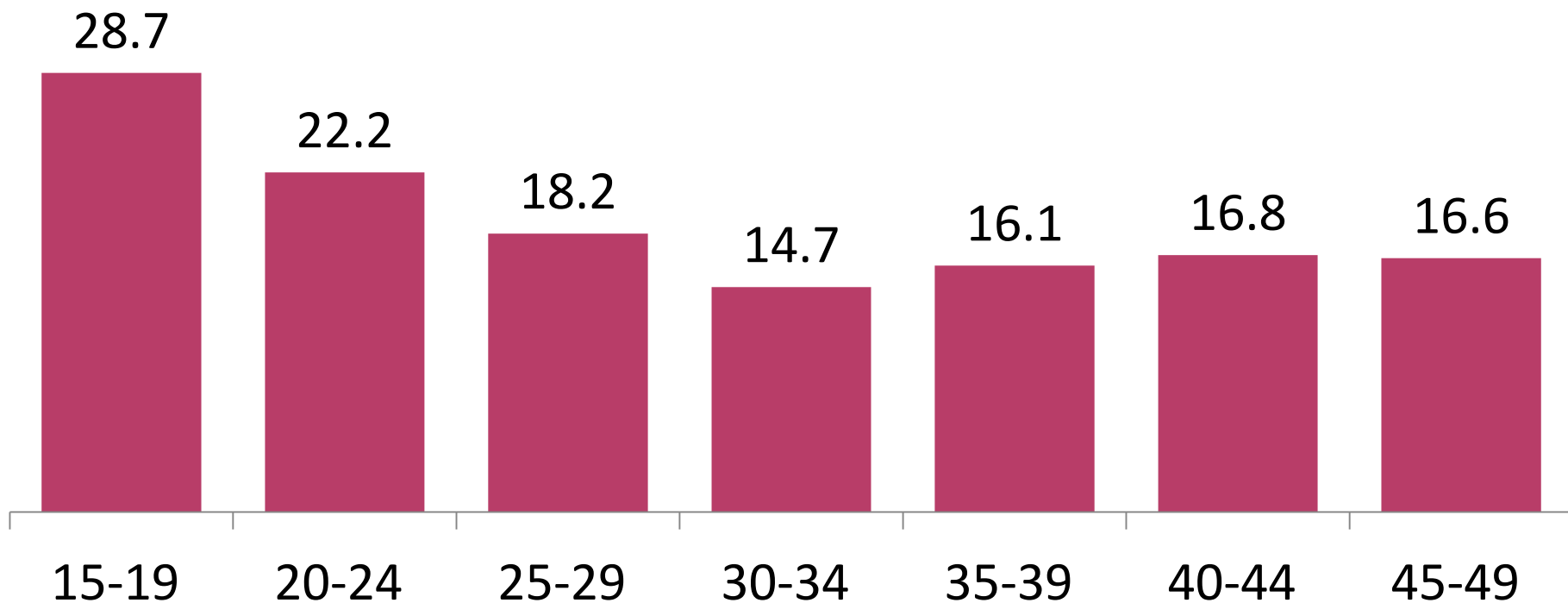


## Percent of All Young Women by Contraceptive Method Currently Used



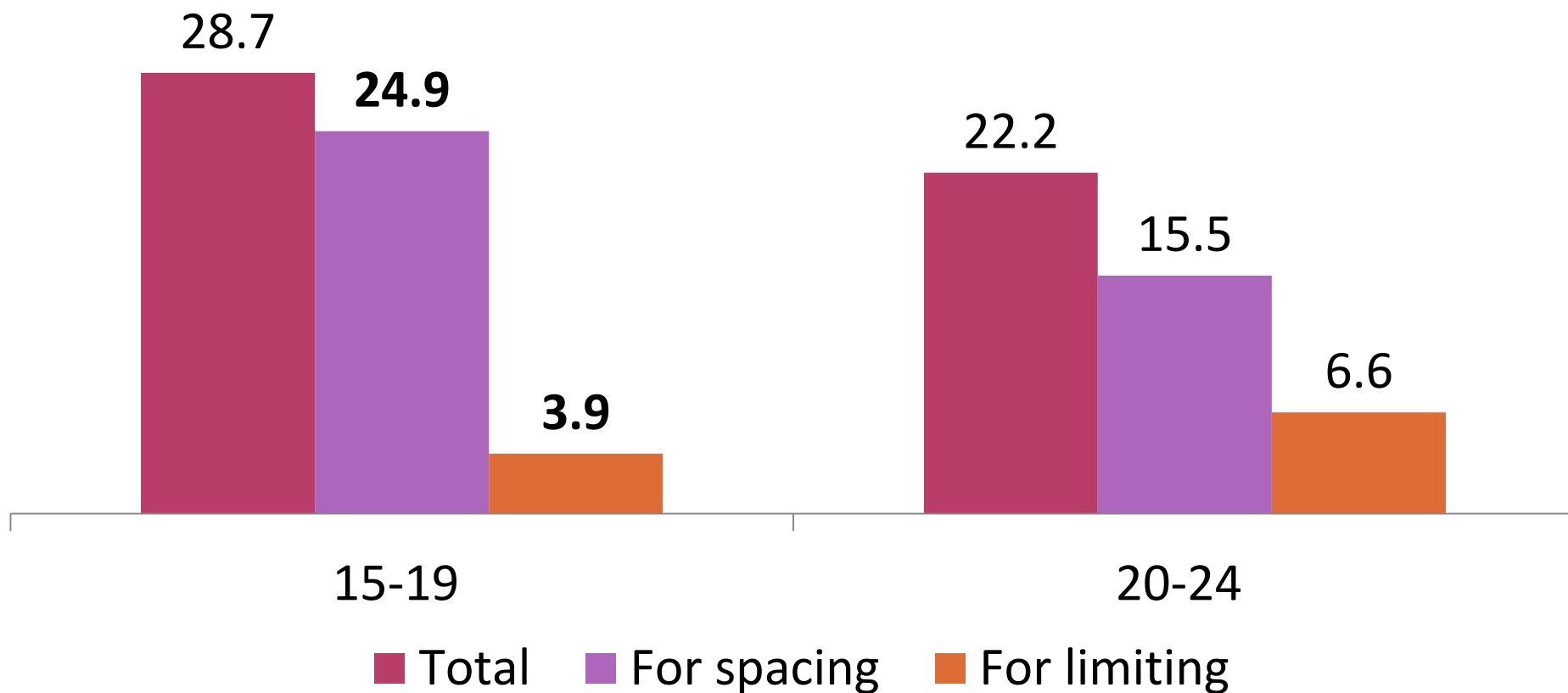


## Percentage of Currently Married Women Age 15-49 with Unmet Need for Family Planning

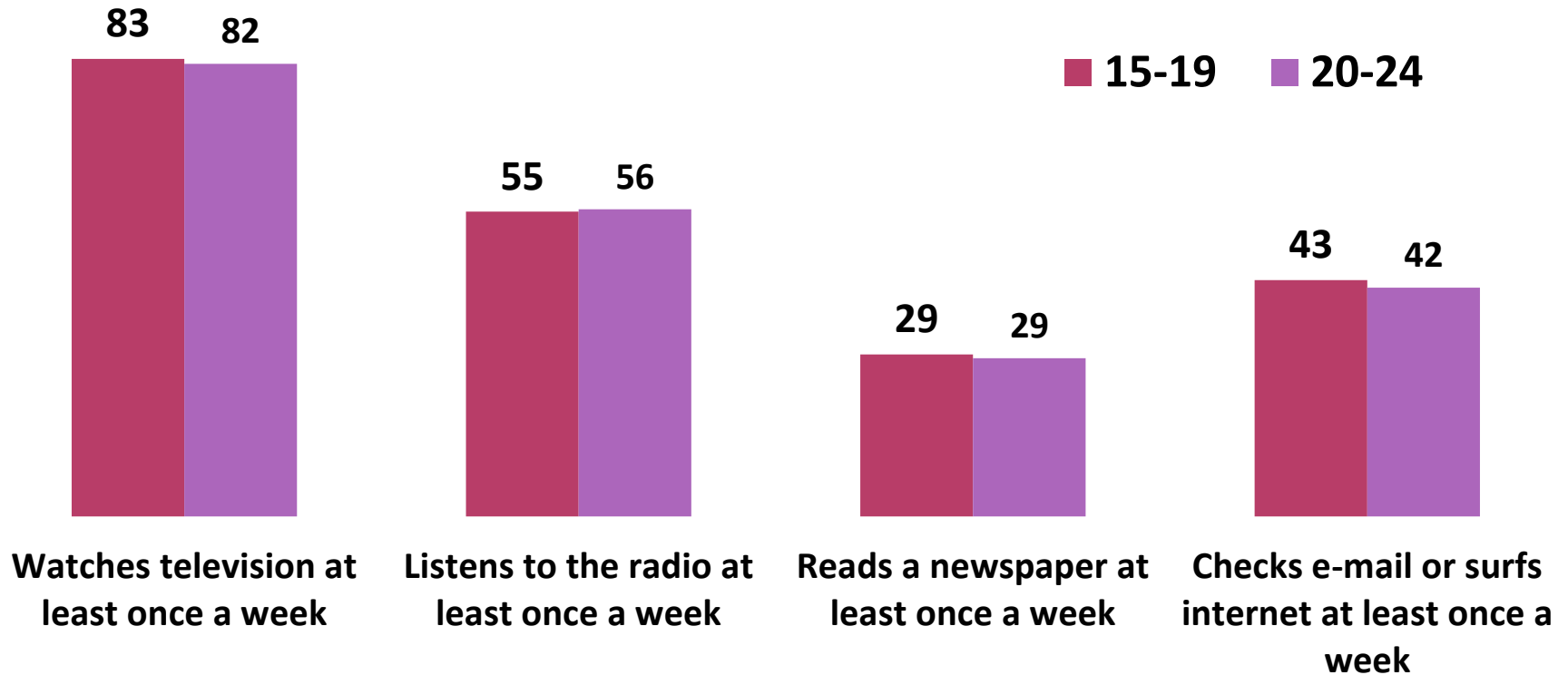
