



Total Fertility Rate based on various rounds of NDS/NDHS








TFR = 3.0 births per woman translates to 2.4M births in 2013





Age-specific fertility rates, 1973-2013








Mean Ideal Number of Children by Age Group

Percentage of women age 15-24 who had sexual intercourse before age 15










Percentage of women age 18-24 who had sexual intercourse before age 18



Percent of Currently Married Women Using Any Contraceptive Method






Percent of All Young Women by Contraceptive Method Currently Used








Percentage of Currently Married Women Age 15-49 with Unmet Need for Family Planning




