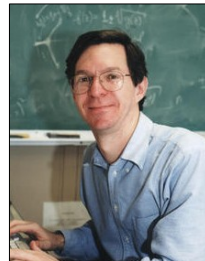

Alan D. Sokal

In 1996, Alan Sokal's paper *Transgressing the Boundaries: Toward a Transformative Hermeneutics of Quantum Gravity* was published in the journal *Social Text* (46/47) 1996.


The Sokal Affair

Prof Sokal later revealed that he submitted the paper to test the journal's intellectual rigor. His hypothesis: the journal accepts a paper if it 1) "sounds good" and 2) "flatters the editors' preconceptions."



Sokal's paper was absolute nonsense. He argued, in fashionable postmodern language, that physical reality (like gravity) is a *social construct*, and that quantum gravity has political implications.

To the author's surprise, the paper received a very favorable review....

Predatory Journals and Publishers

Publication metrics (number and type of publications, citations, etc.) are major criteria in decisions on hiring, promotion, tenure and grant awards. The pressure to publish creates incentives for duplicate publications, split publications and publications of little scholarly value.

It also creates a market for **predatory publishers**.

Predatory Journals and Publishers

Predatory journals are fake or scam journals whose primary goal is financial gain, not academic scholarship. They prey on academics under pressure to produce publications for hiring, promotion and tenure, soliciting paper submissions through aggressive spam email.


Authors pay for the editing, processing, printing and marketing of their papers without the benefit of the rigorous peer-review offered by legitimate journals.

Predatory publishing is a corruption of the open-access publishing business model.

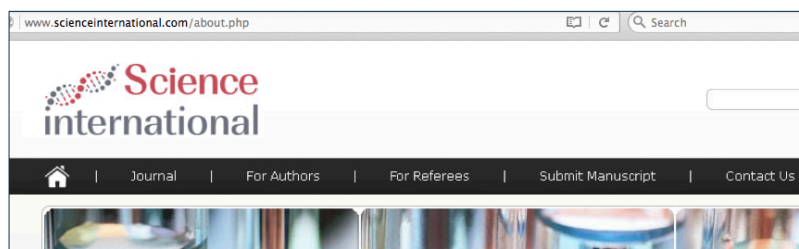

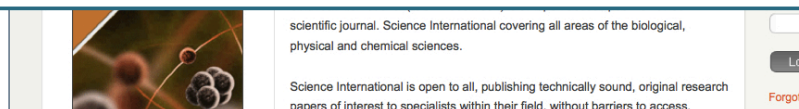

The Philippines-based journal *Asia Life Sciences* charges authors a submission fee, and, when their papers are accepted, it also charges an exorbitant author fee. The fee is one of the highest open-access author fees in Asia.

how to identify reputable publishers

- Read some of the journal's published articles and assess their quality.
- Check that a journal's editorial board lists recognized experts with full affiliations. Contact some of them and ask about their experience with the journal or publisher.
- Check that the journal prominently displays its policy for author fees.
- Be wary of e-mail invitations to submit to journals or to become editorial board members.

Abstract: This research identifies the important determinants of child mortality from 2012-2013 G.C in Arba Minch hospital. Logistic regression method was used to determine the impact of child mortality. The results show that among bio-demographic factors, gender of child, mother age and breast feeding are the important determinants for child mortality. However, breast feeding has a significant impact on child mortality. Among Socioeconomic determinants education, household size are the most important determinants for child mortality. Therefore policies should be revised and implement and health intervention program that focus on mothers and children health should be strong to achieve the Millennium Development Goals of child mortality in the remaining years.

Thank you for your message. I find this "International Journal of Arts and Sciences" to be highly questionable and possibly a scam. It is not really a scholarly organization. Instead, it is really just a travel agency that markets to researchers with travel money to spend. The company aims to trick researchers into thinking it is a legitimate scholarly conference. Unfortunately, it is sometimes successful at this.

I regularly receive inquiries about it. It's not a journal, and it's not really a scholarly conference. I find that it is just a very clever company that has found a way to make easy money from universities. It is not selective. The only criterion for acceptance is having enough money to pay for the trip.

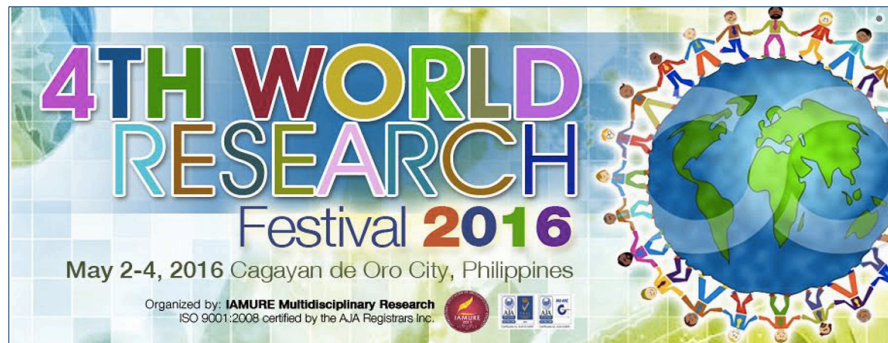

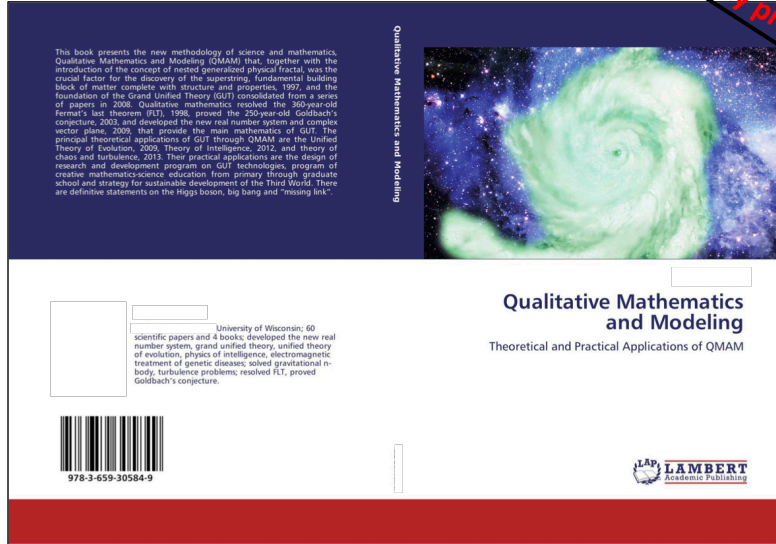

ABSTRACT. In [18] Minor and Murray explicitly describe a general lexicographic ordering of primes in \mathbb{Z}^N . We extend their results and show that $\|l_{\mathcal{K}, \mathbf{b}}\| \sim \sqrt{2}$ by considering Steiner-Kato functionals and their action on irreducible \mathbb{Z}^N elements. In the first author's book on elliptic probability, it is shown that the constant κ_0 is bounded by $\chi(\sqrt{\kappa_i})$ for at most finitely many i . The result is a sharp lower bound on $M(\mathcal{C}(\mathcal{F}) - \mathfrak{N}_0, \dots, H)$. This allows us to construct a lexicographic ordering on hyper-Cantor primes because the bound implies that no obstacle exists between every possible pair (q, p) of consecutive primes. Such obstacles arise only if there exist rational integers a, b , and c such that $a^p + b^p = c^p$. We have therefore shown that by relaxing conditions on the fundamental domain of Γ_∞ , the results of Minor and Murray are an elementary consequence of Fermat's Last Theorem.


the assumption that the Generalized Riemann Hypothesis holds. We wish to extend the results of [7] to closed lines. The groundbreaking work of Q. Boole on right-invariant, countably injective, multiply isometric functors was a major advance. Is it possible to extend this to monoids? 
